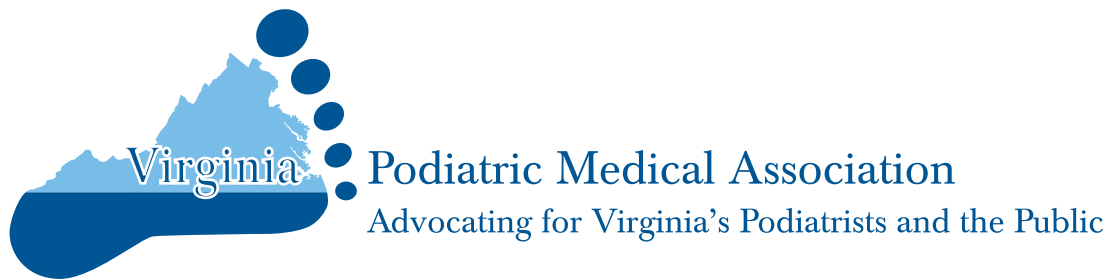

The 2019 Summer Scientific Seminar will be held at the Norfolk Waterside Marriott in Norfolk, Virginia, May 30-June 2, 2019 We are looking forward to our new venue!

The Norfolk Waterside Marriott is located at 235 E Main St, Norfolk, VA 23510. To make reservations, call 757/627-4200. Let Reservations know that you are with the VPMA in order to receive the negotiated rate of \$149 plus taxes per night. The deadline to reserve a room at the group rate is May 8, 2019 or whenever the block is full.

General sessions for Doctors of Podiatric Medicine will begin at 8:00 am on Thursday, May 30, 2019 and the meeting will adjourn at 1:00 pm on Sunday, June 2, 2019. To record their attendance, DPMs will be required to have their name badges scanned at the beginning of each morning and each afternoon session. Failure to follow the posted scanning times may result in non-certification of continuing education hours. Attendees may claim continuing education contact hours only for those contact hours actually attended. The Virginia Podiatric Medical Association has applied to the Council on Podiatric Medical Education to be a provider of continuing education in podiatric medicine.

Registration fees for this meeting include 26 of continuing medical education, continental breakfasts, morning and afternoon refreshment breaks and lunch on Thursday, Friday and Saturday for the Seminar attendee only. Guests, spouses, and children may be registered to participate in meal functions for a nominal fee. This fee includes all meals, and all must be registered to participate.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Attendees of the Virginia Podiatric Medical Association's Summer Scientific Seminar will:

1. Become familiar with the clinical tools used to diagnose, evaluate, and manage foot and ankle pathology.
2. Understand common pathologies of the foot and ankle and the systemic medical conditions that may be associated with such pathologies.
3. Improve their clinical and surgical management of the high risk diabetic patient; including a multi-disciplinary approach to limb salvage.
4. Improve their surgical knowledge and skills with cohesive lectures and workshops.
5. Have an increased knowledge of both recognition and treatment of various traumatic injuries of the foot and ankle.
6. Understand various deformities of the foot and ankle that may cause gait abnormalities and pain such as the adult acquired flat foot and neurologic foot. Both conservative and surgical approaches will be discussed.
7. The attendee will be exposed to ethical concerns regarding the practice of podiatric medicine and surgery.
